Chad grew up in Oxford and spent 17 years developing his eccentric, bittersweet view of the world before fumbling his first acoustic guitar chords on arrival in his adopted home of Norwich. Early steps saw him perform a BBC Introducing Session and record for broadcast on New York's Breakthrough Radio.

His debut album, 2011's "The Meandering Mind of Chad Mason" mixed the atmospheres of a Morricone soundtrack with the innocence of early Fairport, while live he strips it back, building a witty rapport with merely guitar, harmonica and his plaintive baritone. Promotions for the album took him from Edinburgh to London, and from open mics in New York to perform in Austin, Texas during SXSW 2013. Latitude festival that same year was a particular highlight, with Future Radio broadcasting live highlights. A return to Latitude in 2015 heralded further journeys – including a first trip north for Salford Music Festival.

Chad began 2016 playing London's legendary Bob Dylan-hangout The Troubadour and festivals appearances included Folk East, Folk on The Pier and a return to Norwich Sound and Vision. November saw him supporting Steve Tilston and Milly Hirst. 2017 has been focused on recording his third release, which looks to be self-titled. Confirmed festival appearances for 2017 include Folk in a Field and Unplugged by the Sea.
